### **CONCLUSIONS**

#### **of the Meeting of Engineers Chambers of South-eastern Europe**

At the meeting of Engineers Chambers of South-eastern Europe, held in Kotor from April 8 to 10, 2010 and organized by Montenegrin Chamber of Engineers, the following conclusions were made:

- To send a letter of support to Montenegrin Chamber of Engineers with the aim of returning seized jurisdiction and to send such a letter to the Government of Montenegro, with the proposal for the members of Executive Board of ECEC to take a similar step;
- To intensify cooperation between the Engineers Chambers, and to try to achieve common interests in the name of engineering professions;
- To establish national Engineers Chambers as unique institutions, in accordance with regulations for ensuring the public interest and protection of third parties;
- To determine the type and degree of education, and in particular orientations and experience in relevant work, as well as acquiring the status of authorized person to perform the type of work in spatial planning and building construction;
- To determine the status and freedom of certified planner and certified engineer for free performances on a unique market with full responsibility for the consequences that may arise from one's work;
- That national Engineers Chambers need to work on protection of public interest, third parties and expertise in the area of spatial planning and building construction, establishing whether the conditions of legal and physical entities are met, both domestic

and foreign entities, and issuing licenses and authorizations which are public act;

- To create a memorandum of interested Chambers on project candidature on introducing euro codes as national standards for funding from the European Union accession funds before the end of this year. To specify the structure and dynamics of the business in memorandum, as well as the costs of each state participating in the project;
- Introduce the practice of gradation of licenses in order to raise the quality of professional activities.
- To work mutually on introduction of euro codes and define national documents and parameters.
